

Understanding the World.

Look at family photos, talk about own immediate family and friends.

Children to explore home corner roleplay, using resources to imitate actions from own culture.

Looking at our self-portraits talk about how are different to each other.

Use the class height chart to measure each other and discuss who is tallest/smallest. How do we think we will change as we get older?

Children to have access to technological toys.

Creative Development

Children to create a life size portrait of themselves, by drawing around each other.

Painting family portraits.

Making musical instruments with a variety of materials.

Explore how colours can be changed.

Use playdough to create a model of our faces.

Make puppets linked to stories we are covering.

Literacy

Stories we will be using during this topic- Elma, Titch, Charlie and Lola, Biff chip and books.

Encourage children to join in with familiar songs and rhymes.

Children to draw characters from stories they have heard.

Go on a sound walk, what sounds can we hear?

Look at different animals, what sound do they make?

Children to become familiar and confident in the setting, separating from main carer without needing support.

Emotions- what makes us feel happy, sad...

Explore how our actions affect others.

Children to learn and be aware of the Pre-school rules.

Children to bring in a special object from and talk about why it is special to them.

Physical Development

Miss Smith to teach main PE lessons.

Children to explore different ways of moving around, crawling, jumping, hopping.

Children to use one handed tools, jugs and cups in water, hammers and play dough and mark making tools.

Throwing and catching using large balls.

Numeracy

Children to count and recognise numbers to 5.

Courting rhymes- 5 little Ducks, 5 little speckled Frogs..

Number duck fishing.

Number puzzles.

Children to create pictures of their houses using basic 2D shapes.
