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School Uniform

Children must wear:

- Grey or black trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- **White** polo shirt (available with school logo but not essential)
- Red school jumper, cardigan or fleece with school logo
- Red checked or striped summer dress
- Black shoes for all pupils or black trainers but **no coloured strips or markings.**
- **No open toed or strappy heeled sandals or high heel shoes**
- **All footwear must have a solid sole with plenty of grip so that children do not slip in the wet or whilst playing on the large equipment in the park.**

We ask for your support in ensuring your children are sent to school in appropriate footwear, not unsafe sandals or coloured trainers.

Jewellery Policy

It is the policy of the school that the wearing of jewellery is forbidden with the exception of the following:

A sensible watch to help children learn to tell the time. Watches will need to be removed for PE lessons by the child his/herself.

Stud earrings for children who have their ears pierced. Dangling earrings including hoops are not acceptable as they can catch easily and be ripped out. For safety reasons stud earrings will need to be removed for PE lessons by the child his/herself.

If a child is too young or otherwise incapable of removing and replacing either earrings or a watch, parents should ensure that they do not wear these items on PE days.

We believe in making all children feel equal, safe and part of the school community. Dressing appropriately for school and PE encourages a sense of pride and belonging in our children. Standing out by wearing the wrong clothes, shoes or inappropriate jewellery can have a negative impact on behaviour and attitude. As a school we strive to provide every child the opportunity to succeed in all aspects of their school life and to understand the benefits of following collective rules.
