Last week all of Rendell Primary School had a Black History week. Each year learnt about a different famous person. Foundation introduced the assembly by showing pictures they had painted of themselves, showing how everyone is different.

Year 1 learnt about soul music and made collages of different instruments used in soul music.

Year 2 learnt about Mary Seacole and they read sections of information about her life as a nurse, helping injured British soldiers.

Year 3 learnt about Jesse Owens who was the first black American to win 4 gold medals at the Berlin Olympics, in 1936.

Year 4 performed a short play about Rosa Parks who stood up for equal rights when she was asked to give up her seat for a white American. This protest lasted for over a year and other black Americans supported her by refusing to use the bus as well. Finally, the bus company gave in and white and blacks could sit together.

Year 5 learnt about a man who needs no mention, Bob Marley! Bob Marley sold millions of records worldwide. Sadly he died young because of cancer but his memories live on through his music.

Year 6 learnt about Nelson Mandela. He was jailed for 25 years in South Africa. Sadly he died 2 years ago but his legacy still lives through his people.
