



## Key Stage 2 SATs Results Summer 2016

We are very proud of the achievement of our pupils at Rendell Primary School. The children, their parents and the school staff strive to ensure that our children achieve the very best outcomes possible.

From 2016, National Curriculum levels have been abolished. Instead, pupils are given scaled SATs scores in Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation (GPS), Reading and Maths. To calculate a pupil score, their raw test score is converted into a scaled score. This is used to show the has achieved the national standard for that subject.

Teacher assessment is used to measure attainment in Writing and Science. In writing, pupils were assessed against three standards:

- Working towards the expected standard
- Working at the expected standard
- Working at a greater depth within the expected standard

In Science pupils were assessed against two standards:

- Has not met the expected standard
- Working at the expected standard
