We will begin as Geographers, exploring London, the capital city of England and some famous landmarks.

As Historians, we will learn about the Monarchy and what it means to have a King or Queen. We will look at the royal family and the succession to the throne.

Our learning will then move to focus on bees and their roles within the hive. We will explore the vital role that bees have within pollination, which will link to our Science unit about plants.

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We will learn about David Attenborough and his work around conservation. After designing our own bee gardens, we will design and create a bee structure using recycled products. As Artists, through observation of Georgia O'Keefe's artwork, we will use a range of brushes and paints to create our own paintings of flowers, combining these to create a large class meadow.
