We will learn about Space. We will sing songs to help us learn the names of the planets in our Solar System and look at asteroids and aliens.

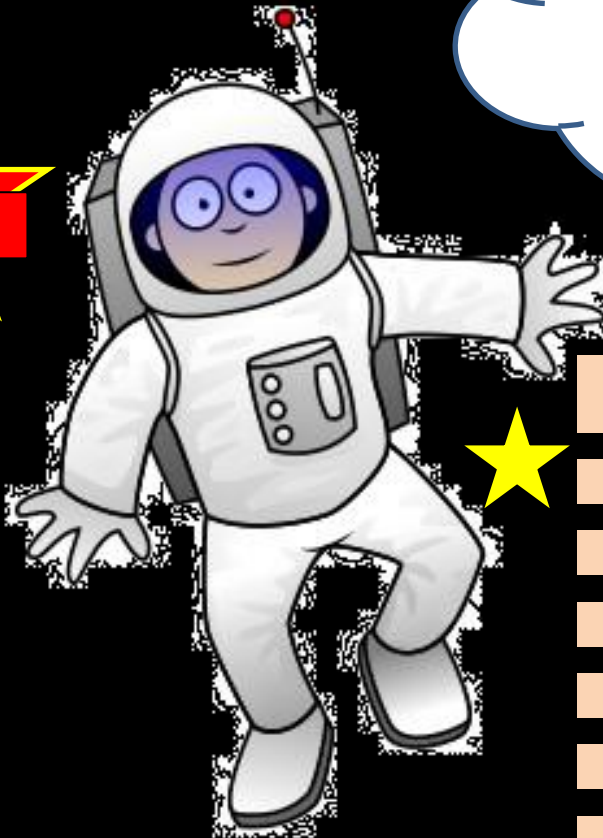
