I. We will be historians recapping our knowledge of historical periods, people and events. We will begin to complete a timeline of British history and compare this to the time-period of the Mayan civilization.

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3. Later, we will be historians and learn about the daily life and times of the Mayan civilization. We will research daily life, entertainment, religion and homes so that we can use this knowledge to compare the Mayan way of life with our own. We will also consider Mayan developments such as their alphabet and calendar. 2. Next, we will be geographers building on the knowledge gained in our pervious unit so that we can learn about human and physical features of Mesoamerica.

4. Finally, we will explore the work of the artist Dag Weiser comparing his masks to traditional Mayan masks before designing and creating our own.
