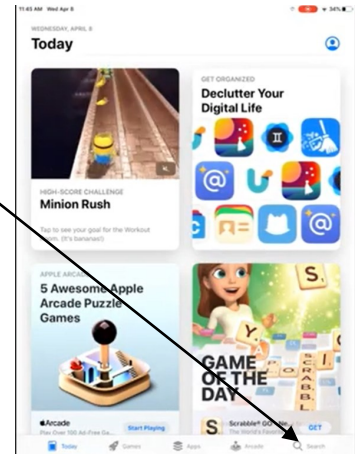


How to download Google Classroom for the iPad

1. Go onto the App Store.



2. Click on the search button.

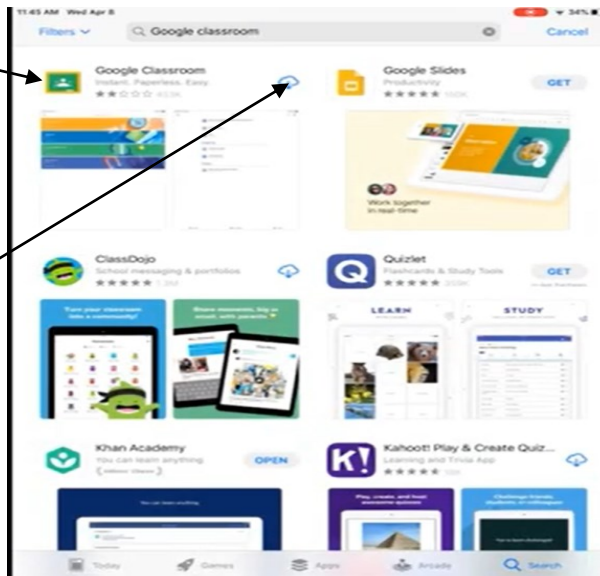


3. Type in 'Google Classroom' in the search bar. The icon looks like this.

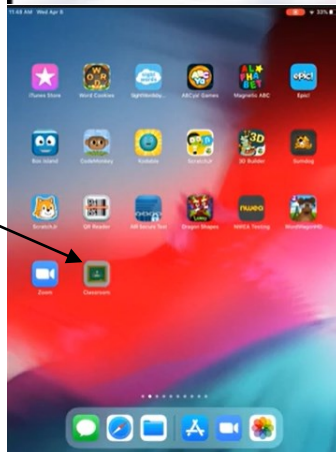


It should be the first result.

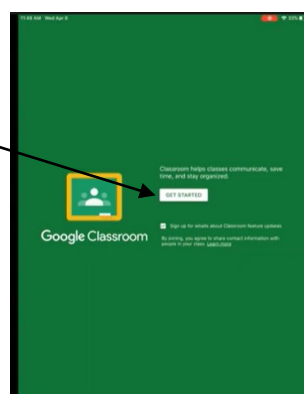
4. Click on 'Get' to download the App.



5. You should now have it downloaded onto your device. Click the App to open it.

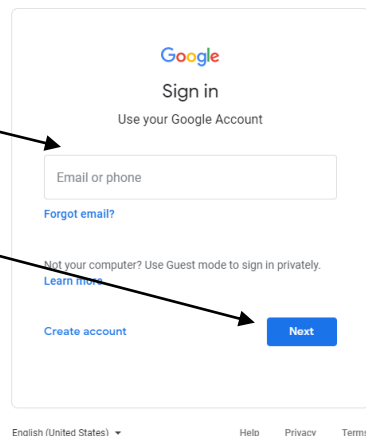


6. Click 'Get started' and then follow the instructions to log in.



How to log into Google Classroom for the iPad continued

7. Type your child's E-mail address into the 'Email or phone' box. Then, click next.



If this box does not appear and you are asked for a 'class code', you will need to log out of the Google account the iPad is already logged into. Then, log in using your child's username and password.

To do this:

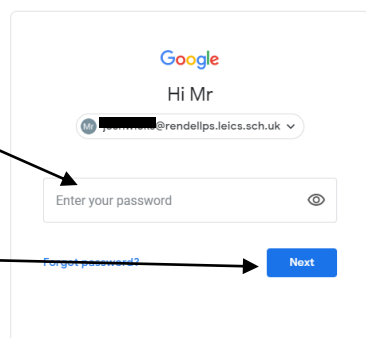
- At the top, tap your profile image or initial.
- Select or add your child's account.

If the above does not work:

- Go to the settings app on your iPad
- Tap your Apple ID banner
- Sign out
- Sign in with your child's details

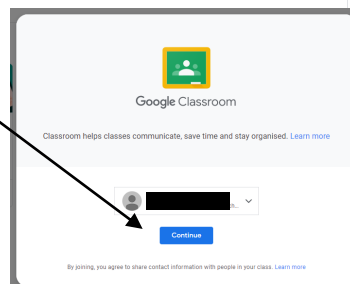
8 Type their password into the 'password' box. (It is case sensitive!)

Then, click next.

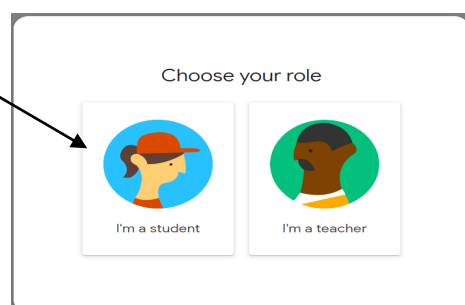


9. If your child hasn't already logged in, you will need to click continue.

If they have, skip to step 11.

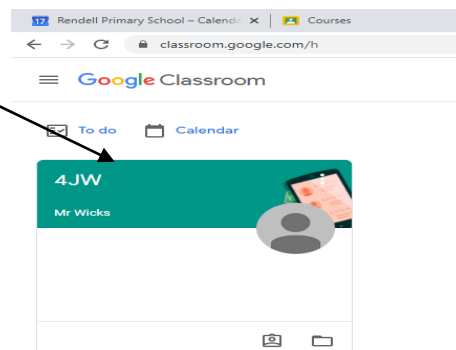


10. You will then need to select 'I'm a student'.

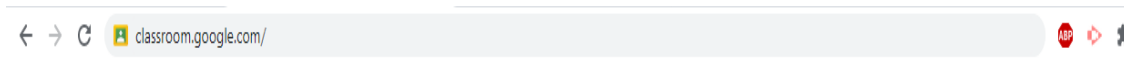


11. Your child will need to select their class and click on the big icon.

This will take them to their class page where they will find the set learning.

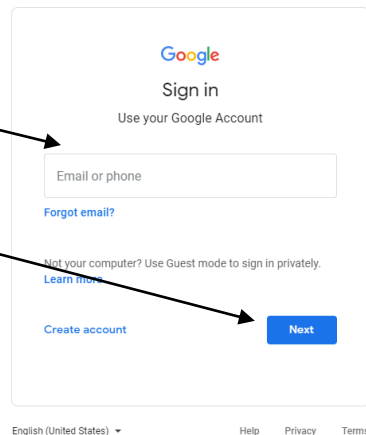


How to log in to Google Classroom from a computer or laptop



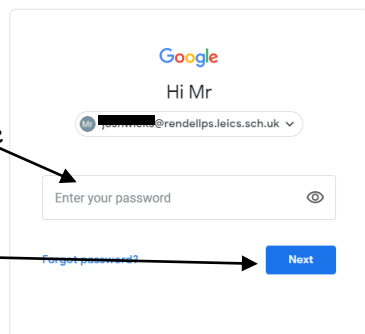
1. Type **classroom.google.com** into the URL box in your browser.

2. Type your child's E-mail address into the 'Email or phone' box. Then, click next.



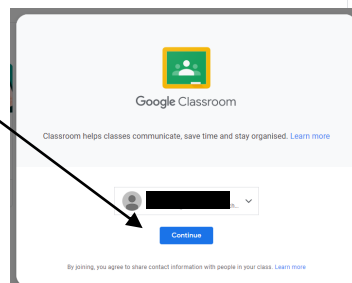
3. Type their password into the 'password' box. (It is case sensitive!)

Then, click next.

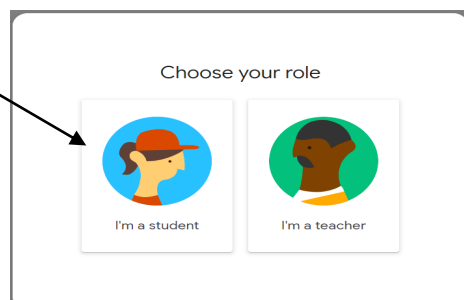


4. If your child hasn't already logged in, you will need to click continue.

If they have, skip to step 6.

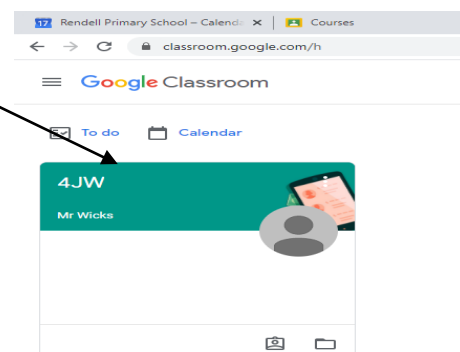


5. You will then need to select 'I'm a student'.



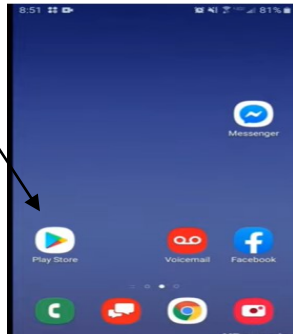
6. Your child will need to select their class and click on the big icon.

This will take them to their class page where they will find the set learning.



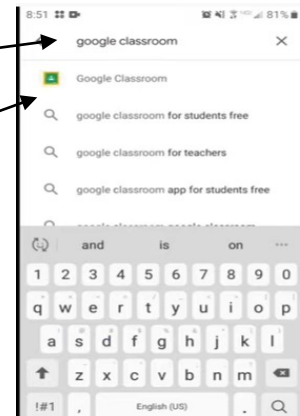
How to download Google Classroom for an Android device

1. Go onto the Play Store.

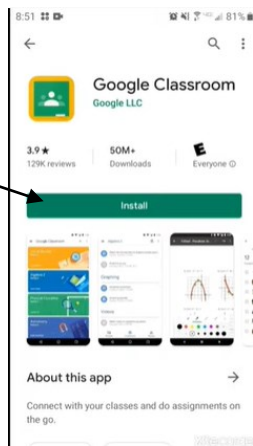


2. Click on the search button and type in 'Google Classroom'.

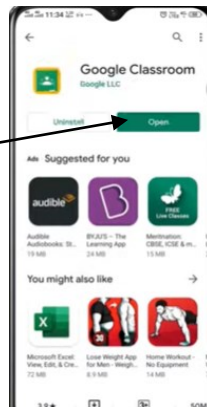
It should pop up with the icon looking like this:



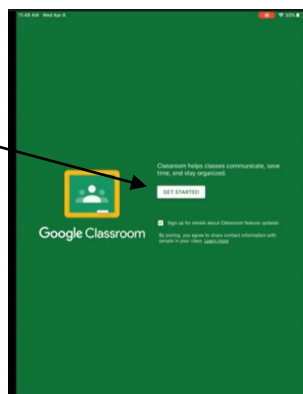
3. Click on 'Install' to download the App.



4. You should now have it downloaded onto your device. Click on 'Open' to open the App.




5. Click 'Get started' and then follow the instructions to log in.








