Every Friday, your child will bring home a phonics book containing a QR code/s. By scanning the QR code, you will be able to access videos of the sounds your child has learned that week, as well as some fun activities and games to practise them together. Please spend a little time each week revisiting these sounds with your child. Regular practice at home will help your child build confidence and develop their early reading and writing skills.	Every Friday, school will email you a document outlining what your child will be learning and doing in school the following week. It will also include some simple questions and ideas that you can use at home to talk to your child and support their learning. This is a great opportunity to revisit their learning together and help them feel confident and prepared for the week ahead.	In due course your child will be given a log in to Numbots. This is an app that can be downloaded and played on a device. It is a fun and engaging way to support number fluency and recall in basic mental maths.

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
