

We will start this unit of work as artists. We will explore primary and secondary colours and look at the work of Picasso, Gores and other portrait artists.



Using early sketching skills, we will draw our own portraits. We will then create a self-portrait in collage form, influenced by the artists and pieces we have looked at.



We will also create digital self-portraits using the iPads and compare them to the painted art they have made.

As scientists, we will learn the different parts of the body and the role each part has. We will focus on our personal history and look at how we have changed since birth.

We will be historians, developing an understanding of the past and the present. We will investigate what our school was like in the past, interviewing past pupils and analyse old artefacts including books, files and photos.



We will focus on the world around us, the local area and reading maps. As geographers, we will take a walk around Loughborough, and draw a simple plan of key features. We will use our own address to write a postcard to someone at home.

Remaining as geographers, we will explore directional language and use a simple picture map to navigate around school. Using the geography skills we have learnt, we will create a map from a birds eye view.
