# Phonics in Year 1

- In Year 1, your child will continue to build there prior phonics knowledge using the Read Write Inc (RWI) phonics scheme.
- Phonics is the ability to convert a letter or letter group into sounds that are then blended together into a word.
- Phonics will be taught systematically each day for approximately 25 minutes.
- Spending 5-10 minutes at home recapping previously taught sounds will benefit your child immensely.
