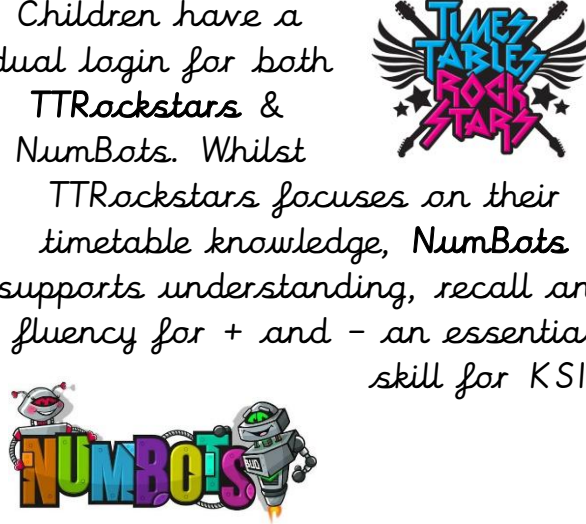


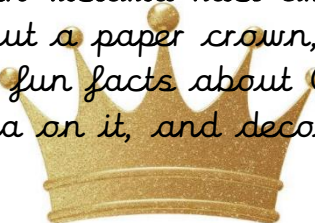
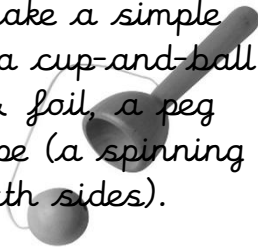
Year 2 Rendell Homework Grid Autumn 2026-27

Reading	Spelling	Maths
Children are to read at least 4 times a week to an adult at home. Children will be given both a reading book for their level and a reading for pleasure book to be enjoyed at home. Reading needs to be logged onto the BoomReader App. Children who log their reading regularly are in with the chance of a weekly and a termly prize! Curriculum Tasks

Queen Victoria Fact Crown: Cut out a paper crown, write three fun facts about Queen Victoria on it, and decorate it.
