### **BoomReader – Our Reading Tracker**

In our class, we use *BoomReader* to keep track of all the books we read. Every time we finish a book, we log it on the app. It's a great app because we can see how many books we've read and try to beat our own records. It makes reading feel like a challenge.



### **TT Rockstars – Key Stage 2**

TT Rockstars is one of the most exciting apps we use! It helps us practise our times tables, but in a fun, game-like way. You can become a "rockstar" by answering questions quickly. Sometimes we even have battles with our classmates.



### **NumBots – Key Stage 1**
